We are so glad that you and your team are considering joining us in our 2019 project. We would like to give you a very brief overview of what we will do “on the field” and “at our accommodation” as you prayerfully consider and decide.

On the Field

Next year our project will take place in the trendy east inner-city neighbourhood called Woodstock – Cape Town, South Africa (For more about Woodstock please see the attachment titled “Two Stories – God’s and Woodstock’s”). Our main objective will be to support the church planting work of Wesley and Nicole Marshall. They will be planting Redemption City Church, a baptistic church, that desires to see the diverse community of Woodstock come together to worship the one and only true God. They desire to see disciples made, who in turn make other disciples. They desire to be a church that flourishes, seeking the peace and prosperity of their neighbourhood. They desire to be a church who plants other churches. They distinctly aim to be Gospel-Centred, Community-Focused, City-Focused and Cross-Cultural. We will support this church plant in it’s “Cultivation Phase”, wherein it seeks to develop a core group of people with which it will launch early 2020. The following ministries will enable us to provide this support:

- Holiday Bible Club – This year this will be one of our main ministries. We will minister to children between the ages of 7 – 12 years of age, employing a variety of stimuli.
- Skateboard Clinics – We will be making use of a newly built skate park to teach interested children the basics of skateboarding, life skills and the gospel.
- Street Evangelism – We will take to the streets each day, seeking opportunities to speak to people about the new church plant and possibly present the gospel to them, as well as doing some bible study.

At our Accommodation

One of the premier features of this short term project is the daily worship and training sessions which all participants are a part of. These sessions help equip the participant for the work they will be doing. It also aims to challenge each participant at heart level, pointing them to the God and the works He’s done for us in Christ Jesus.
